Associate Professor Dr Huali Wang, China

Dr. Huali Wang graduated from Beijing Medical University in 1994. She obtained her MD/PhD in 2001 from Peking University. Dr. Wang won a grant to train at the International Mental Health Research at Harvard Medical School. She then went on for her postdoctoral training at the University of California. Currently she is an associate Professor of geriatric psychiatry, serves as the vice chair for Clinical Research Division and is an Associate Director of Dementia Care & Research Center at Peking University Institute of Mental Health. Dr. Wang actively participates in national and international mental health research advocacy in recent years, serving as Board of Directors, of the International Psychogeriatric Association (IPA), Vice Chair of Chinese Association of Alzheimer's disease and Associated Disorders (Alzheimer's Disease Chinese), Vice Chair of Aging Psychology Professional Committee affiliated with Chinese Society for Gerontology and as the Secretary for Psychogeriatric Interest Group of Chinese Society for Psychiatry. Her main research is on Alzheimer's disease and mild cognitive impairment. Since 1998, she has developed a standard case registry and database of individuals with dementia and mild cognitive impairment at Peking University Institute of Mental Health. Dr. Wang leads several research projects on dementia and cognitive impairment, including "Multidimensional predictors of MCI-AD conversion", "Neuroimaging and plasma biomarkers of MCI-AD conversion", "Neurobiological markers of cognitive impairment associated with late-onset depression", "Chinese Dementia Care Research Center: Infrastructure and pilot study", "Caregiving experiences and care-seeking modalities in Chinese culture", and "Community-based integrated intervention for family caregivers of people with dementia". Dr. Wang's team has published their work on Radiology, Dementia and Geriatric Cognitive Disorders, Alzheimer Disease & Associated Disorders and other peer-reviewed journals. She has been invited as peer-reviewer for the Journal of Neurology, Neurosurgery and Psychiatry and the International Journal of Geriatric Psychiatry.
