Professor Dr Ken Nagata, Japan

Dr Nagata graduated from Hirosaki University School of Medicine in 1978, He started his career as a resident at the Institute of Brain and Blood Vessels at Mihara Memorial Hospital and followed through as a neurologist at the same hospital. The period from 1983 to 1984 saw him as a visiting assistant professor at the Department of Neurology, University Colorado School of Medicine (USA). He returned to work as a scientist in the Department of Neurology at the Research Institute for Brain and Blood Vessels, Akita, before becoming its director in 2002, a position he still holds currently. He is a board member of several societies, including International Society for Brain Electromagnetic Topography, International Society for Vascular Cognitive and Behavioral Disorders, International Society of Vascular Dementia, Japanese Society of Clinical Neurophysiology, Japanese Stroke Society and Japanese Society of Cognitive Neuroscience. He is also a fellow of the American Heart Association Stroke Council.
