Professor Dr Manabu Ikeda, Japan

Dr Ikeda studied medicine at the Osaka University in Japan, He embarked on a post graduate study at his alma mater and was awarded a Ph.D. in 1993, From 1996-2006 he worked at the Department of Neuropsychiatry, Ehime University School of Medicine,. He spent a year (2000-2001) at the University of Cambridge Neurology Unit, in Addenbrooke's Hospital.
