Dr Yusoff obtained her Master of Medicine (Psychiatry) in 1994 from the National University of Malaysia. She then went on to train in Psychogeriatrics in UK from 1995-1996. She set up the first psychogeriatric services in Malaysia, including setting up one the early memory clinic practice in the country. Together with a group of volunteers she went on to develop the Johor Bahru Alzheimer Disease Support Association in Johor Bahru, which among other things offer dementia day care activities for the people with dementia in Johor Bahru. She is also active in the development of training curriculum for gerontology nurses, and for both psychiatric post graduate program and the subspecialty fellowship programme for psychogeriatrics. She had also chaired the development committee of the CPG Management of Dementia (both the 1st and 2nd revision) and also sits on the Peer Review Committee for the CPG Management of Acne (2012), Malaysia. She has been involved in several multicentres drug studies and has been invited to present scientific papers at both national and international conferences, as well as reviewer for international journals.
